ABSTRACT

The Office of Religious Affairs is one of the places that organizes some state duties with the main task of carrying out some general government and development tasks in the field of religion. One of the work units of the Ministry of Religion is the Laren District Religious Affairs Office which is located at Jl. Laren Brondong, Gampang, Dadapan, Laren, Lamongan Regency, East Java 62262, Indonesia. The problem that exists in the existing service is the data processing of married couples. The service process is still carried out manually through direct access to the KUA, plus currently the requirements for marriage are increasing, requiring prospective couples to obtain a marriage certificate. This is a bit of a hassle because the couple has to go back and forth to the kua to complete the process. One of the obstacles faced in obtaining a premarital certificate is that couples have to come to the nearest religious affairs office to fill in absenteeism and attend orientation sessions, making it less efficient and less effective. This can be time-consuming and difficult for prospective couples who both work, and the couple has limited knowledge of wedding information. Therefore, "Implementation of a Website-Based Premarital Certificate Service Information System at KUA" aims to overcome this problem. The results of this research are in the form of a web-based application that can simplify service performance at KUA. This system is based on the concept of a website application that users can access online.
