Accountability, Transparency and Community Participation for The Management of Village Funds and Community Welfare

Abstract

This research is quantitative and aims to determine the influence of accountability in village fund management, transparency in village fund management and community participation on community welfare. The dependent variable in this research is community welfare. The independent variables in this research are accountability in village fund management, transparency in village fund management, and community participation. This research was conducted in Sidomoyo Village, Godean District with a research sample of 150 respondents. The sampling technique in this research is purposive sampling technique. The data used in this research uses primary data, by distributing questionnaires to respondents directly. The data analysis technique used in this research uses validity tests, reliability tests, multiple linear tests, coefficient of determination tests (R2) and model feasibility tests (F). The testing in this research used SPSS for Windows version 26 software. The results of this research show that: 1. Accountability in managing village funds has a positive effect on community welfare. 2. Transparency in village fund management does not affect community welfare. 3. Community participation has no effect on community welfare.
