

# **PENGARUH PARENTAL MONITORING DAN FRIENDSHIP QUALITY TERHADAP INTENSI DATING VIOLENCE PADA REMAJA AKHIR**

## **ABSTRAK**

*Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui pengaruh parental monitoring dan friendship quality terhadap intensi dating violence pada remaja akhir. Penelitian ini mendapatkan 55 responden yang berdomisili di Jawa Timur dengan rentang usia 17 hingga 19 tahun yang mana 40 diantaranya merupakan responden try out terpakai. Jumlah responden laki-laki sebanyak 18 responden dan perempuan sebanyak 37 responden. Berdasarkan kategorisasi menunjukkan responden yang memiliki parental monitoring tinggi ada 16,4%, sedang 69,1%, dan rendah ada 14,5%. Sedangkan responden yang memiliki friendship quality tinggi 18,2%, sedang 70,9%, dan rendah 10,9%. Selain itu, responden yang memiliki intensi dating violence tinggi 20%, sedang 74,5%, dan rendah 5,5%. Hasil uji regresi berganda menunjukkan bahwa parental monitoring dan friendship quality terhadap intensi dating violence pada remaja akhir memiliki nilai signifikansi sebesar  $0,045 < 0,05$  sehingga  $H_a$  diterima. Artinya, terdapat pengaruh yang signifikan parental monitoring dan friendship quality terhadap intensi dating violence pada remaja akhir. Hasil tersebut menunjukkan bahwa parental monitoring dan friendship quality memiliki kontribusi sebesar 11,3% terhadap intensi dating violence pada remaja akhir.*

# THE INFLUENCE OF PARENTAL MONITORING AND FRIENDSHIP QUALITY TOWARDS DATING VIOLENCE INTENTION AMONG LATE ADOLESCENTS

## ABSTRACT

*This study aims to determine the effect of parental monitoring and friendship quality towards dating violence intention among late adolescents. The respondents involved were 55 respondents from East Java with a range of ages 17 to 19 years which 40 respondents were from used try out. The number of male respondents was 18 and female respondents were 37. Based on categorization it shows that respondents who have high parental monitoring 16.4%, medium 69.1%, and low 14.5%. While respondents who have high friendship quality are 18.2%, medium are 70.9%, and low are 10.9%. In addition, respondents who had dating violence were high 20%, moderate 74.5%, and low 5.5%. The results of the multiple regression test showed that parental monitoring and friendship quality toward dating violence intention among late adolescents had a significance value of  $0.045 < 0.05$  so that  $H_a$  was accepted. It means, there is a significant influence of parental monitoring and friendship quality towards dating violence intention in late adolescents. These results indicate that parental monitoring and friendship quality contribute 11.3% towards dating violence intention among late adolescents.*
