Abstrak

Sektor transportasi merupakan salah satu subsektor dari sektor infrastruktur di Bursa Efek Indonesia (BEI). Infrastruktur merupakan salah satu faktor penentu pembangunan ekonomi yang sama pentingnya dengan faktor-faktor produksi umum lainnya seperti modal dan tenaga kerja. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menganalisis pengaruh Profitabilitas, Likuiditas, dan Solvabilitas terhadap Price Earning Ratio (PER). Populasi dalam penelitian ini adalah 10 Perusahaan Subsektor Transportasi yang ada di Indonesia selama periode 2017 sampai 2019. Pemilihan sampel dilakukan dengan metode purposive sampling, sehingga dihasilkan 10 Perusahaan Industri Transportasi untuk dijadikan sampel dalam penelitian ini. Kinerja Keuangan adalah sebuah gambaran pencapaian atau keberhasilan pelaksanaan program perusahaan dalam mewujudkan visi dan misi organisasi. Penelitian ini menggunakan tiga tahap analisis data, yaitu analisis statistik deskriptif, uji asumsi klasik, dan analisis regresi linear berganda dengan taraf signifikansi 5%. Hasil dari penelitian ini membuktikan bahwa ada pengaruh signifikan dari likuiditas, profitabilitas dan solvabilitas terhadap nilai perusahaan.

Abstract

The transportation sector is one of the sub-sectors of the infrastructure sector on the Indonesia Stock Exchange (IDX). Infrastructure is one of the determinants of economic development which is as important as other general production factors such as capital and labor. This study aims to analyze the effect of Profitability, Liquidity, and Solvency on Price Earning Ratio (PER). The population in this study were 10 Transportation Subsector Companies in Indonesia during the period 2017 to 2019. The purposive sampling method was carried out so that 10 Transportation Industry Companies were produced to be used as samples in this study. Financial Performance is a description of the achievement or success of the company's program implementation in realizing the organization's vision and mission. This study uses three stages of data analysis, namely descriptive statistical analysis, classical assumption test, and multiple linear regression analysis with a significance level of 5%. The results of this study prove that there is a significant effect of liquidity, profitability and solvency on firm value.
